Commitment to Cooperative Effort Expected of All Parents 2019-2020 School Year

As parents of students attending Columbus Christian Academy, we will strive, with God's help, to uphold the following standards so that Christ will be honored in this ministry.

1. We will join with the school and the Holy Spirit in helping our children to make a personal commitment to Jesus Christ and subsequently have a growing relationship with Him.
2. We will strive to serve as Christian role models and promote in our children the qualities of love, respect for authority, respect for property, integrity, honesty, purity, biblical male and female roles, and a commitment to living by the moral standards of the Bible. This includes a traditional marriage relationship between a man and woman as outlined in the Bible.
3. We will strive to support our students as they seek to live out the standards of the CCA Code of Student Conduct.
4. We will resolve conflicts by utilizing the principles outlined in Matthew 18, which specifically states "that we should go directly to the individual(s) involved". Likewise, we will keep problems within the school and not resort to external institutions to resolve our conflicts.

6. We will join with the faculty in promoting good academic training through carefully monitoring our child's academic progress. This would include being aware of the student's average in all subjects and major assignments. Assistance should be provided in such a way as to help the students in weak areas while trying to foster personal initiative and responsibility toward school work.
7. We will support the policies and decisions of our school board, administration, and faculty.
8. We will endeavor to assist the school through attendance at special programs and events.
9. When attending extracurricular activities (i.e., athletic events), we will commit ourselves to exhibiting Christian fan behavior by showing respect for officials and visitors.
10. We will annually recommit ourselves to the principles of Christian education so that we will be a Christian school and not just a private school.
11. We will meet our financial obligations on time.
12. We will recognize that maintaining a quality program will most likely require annual tuition increases.
13. We will read the applicable students handbooks and support the policies stated therein.
14. We will make a commitment to pray on a regular basis for our students, faculty, administration, and board.
